In order to reduce teen pregnancy, every Alaskan should have access to good reproductive education that is science-based and provided at age-appropriate levels throughout schooling years. Access to contraceptives and long-term birth control prescriptions is also critical. I will support adequate funding in all of these areas, and these investments will also help confront our high rates of sexually transmitted infections and improve overall reproductive health access.

Alaska's high rates of sexual assault and sexual abuse are one of the greatest challenges we face as a state, and there is no single answer or policy solution that will protect men, women, and children in our state from being victimized. Clearly, though, education is one part of the solution. Another is making it so every community has law enforcement. We must also find ways to increase the rate of prosecution for sexual assault – which is shockingly low year after year – so that rapists know they will be held accountable. Finally, Alaskans need to speak openly about this issue and take an uncomfortable look at the root causes that make us rank the worst in the country in this area.

9. How important are reproductive health rights to you personally, and why?

Increasing access to high-quality, affordable healthcare will improve the lives of countless Alaskans; access to reproductive healthcare and family planning is a critical component of overall health. The significance of this fact was proven in the years since I acted to unilaterally expand access to Medicaid when the Legislature would not act and let politics get in the way of good policy. Because of my decision, 70,000 people in our state now have access to life-saving healthcare, the rate of abortion has decreased by 14

percent as fewer women are forced to make the decision for economic reasons, and the State of Alaska brings in more than \$1 billion every year from the expansion group of patients.
