WHEREAS, In 2015, an ordinance was considered by the Borough Assembly
to move Borough elections to vote by mail, and in the past two years, ordinances were
considered to move the Borough election to coincide with the state elections in November
all with the intent of increasing voter turnout; and

WHEREAS, On April 26, 2024, the League of Women Voters (LWV) hosted Voting By Mail: A Community Conversation where the LWV held a forum about voting by mail as an option for borough elections that featured an expert panel to discuss logistics, security, benefits and drawbacks.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Fairbanks North Star Borough (FNSB) Clerk's Office shall facilitate the formation of an Election Task Force, including Clerk's Office staff, residents, and community partners such as the League of Women Voters and Get Out The Native Vote for the purpose of identifying barriers and solutions for implementing a by mail election process and the impact on the Fairbanks North Star Borough; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Fairbanks North Star Borough (FNSB) Assembly directs the Borough Clerk's Office to invite community members representing diverse constituencies from rural parts of the Borough and our Cities to serve on a stakeholder group for the purpose of evaluating and soliciting constituent comments about optional election models to better serve Borough voters and the Borough community; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the FNSB Assembly supports the Borough Clerk's Office as it explores vote by mail elections with a goal to provide a report to the Assembly by December 2025, with possible strategies to increase voter turnout, thus empowering Borough residents with a stronger voice in the democratic process and in the decisions that directly impact their everyday lives.
